# **Description**

The goal of the Foundation is to encourage legal research and writing that will be valuable to Canadian lawyers, notaries and Judges in their day-to-day work, and will also be valuable to the administration of justice. The Foundation has research funding available to jurists, including legal scholars in Canadian Universities, for 2020. The funds are for legal research falling into the following three broad categories:

- Research and writing where the emphasis is on the statement of existing rules of law, sometimes referred to as doctrinal research;
- Research with regard to the working of the legal system; and
- Research with regard to developments in fields peripheral to legal doctrine, such as criminology, psychology, psychiatry, sociology and economics and their relationship to rules of law.

# **Funding Availability**

In 2019, the Canadian Foundation for Legal Research's resources were combined with generous support from the Law Foundation of British Columbia and the Chamber of Notaries of Quebec, allowing the Foundation to award 20 grants totaling about \$145,000. The Foundation is hopeful that the funding for 2020 will permit an increase to the level of support. The precise amount available will be determined early in the new year, but the Foundation is optimistic that they will be able to distribute over \$150,000 with an upper limit of about \$10,000 per grant.
