Description

The mission of the AKC Canine Health Foundation (CHF) is to advance the health of all dogs and their owners by funding sound scientific research and supporting the dissemination of health information to prevent, treat and cure canine disease. This focused call for proposals supports the mission with an emphasis to advance high-quality basic, translational, biomedical, and clinical research to support the health, well-being, and performance of all dogs involved in physical activity, including canine athletes participating in performance and companion sports as well as working dogs.

We encourage proposals that emphasize incorporating a One Health model as a critical tool to achieve CHF's vision of a multidisciplinary approach to address the health needs of all dogs and their people. Basic research as it pertains to exercise, injury, pain, and rehabilitation can involve a wide variety of scientific disciplines, including immunology, molecular biology, genetics, "-omics" tools, structural biology, metabolism, infectious disease and pharmacology. Clinical research proposals may address but are not limited to diagnostic, therapeutic and preventative approaches for the following topics:

- Exercise
- Orthopedics
- Surgery
- Regenerative medicine, tissue engineering and musculoskeletal fitness
- Rehabilitation including alternative modalities (e.g. laser therapy, ultrasound, TENS) and new technologies
