It is anticipated that a Genome Canada Large Scale Applied Research Project (LSARP) competition is to be launched in early 2017. The focus of this funding opportunity will be precision medicine. While the competition objectives, principles and selection and evaluation criteria are still being finalized, Ontario Genomics want to alert you to this pending competition so that potential applicants can begin to prepare.

Funding Availability

Based on past LSARP competitions, projects will likely need to include end users as part of the project teams, be multi-disciplinary (science and social science/humanities), and have a total four-year budget between \$2M-\$10M. Co-funding will be required and project deliverables will need to lead to social and/or economic benefits to Canada.
