## **Description**

Every year, four Balzan Prizes are awarded to scholars and scientists who are distinguished in their fields on an international level. The aim of the Balzan Prize is to foster culture, the sciences and the most outstanding humanitarian initiatives of peace and brotherhood among peoples, regardless of nationality, race or creed.

The subject areas for the 2025 prizes are:

- History of Contemporary Art
- Classic: Athenian Democracy Revisited
- Atoms and Ultra-Precise Measurement of Time
- Gene and Gene-Modified Cell Therapy

# **Eligibility**

The subject areas in which the awards are granted are rotated. No more than four prizes may be awarded in any one year. **Self-nominations are not accepted.** 

#### **Prize**

A monetary prize of 750,000 Swiss Franc (approximately CAD \$995,550). The winners are each required to allocate half of their prize money to funding research projects carried out preferably by young scholars or scientists in their respective fields.
