From 2010-2018, the canola industry and AAFC will have jointly invested close to \$40 million in two canola research clusters funded under Growing Forward 1 and 2. This investment has been integral in helping the industry meet its goals, and has successfully addressed multiple industry-wide priorities. How to Apply

1. Expression of Interest

- LOI's must be submitted on the appropriate [template](#) [5] and must align with one of the research priority areas as described in the document: [Canola Research Priorities for the Next Policy Framework](#) [6] (PDF).
- The deadline for submission of LOI's is **March 13, 2017** at 8:00 am CDT. LOI's may be submitted by email to Lisa Campbell, Oil Nutrition Research Manager at campbell@canolacouncil.org [7].
- Researchers are not required to submit their EOI to the Office of Research for approval before submission to the sponsor. Researchers are asked to send a copy of their EOI to the Office of Research for information purposes only. An OR-5 is not required at the EOI stage. Researchers will be notified by the sponsor if they have been invited to submit a full proposal.

2. Full Proposal

- Only successful applicants will be notified and asked to provide a full research proposal

for consideration. Those invited to submit a full proposal must submit their full proposal to the Office of Research two weeks in advance of the sponsor's deadline with a signed OR-5.
