This funding opportunity will provide funding for research and knowledge mobilization for Indigenous communities (i.e., First Nations, Inuit, Métis and/or Urban Indigenous communities), Indigenous organizations and researchers who identify as Indigenous (or researchers who provide evidence of having [meaningful and culturally safe involvement](#) [7] with Indigenous Peoples) in Canada who are responding to the unique health and well-being needs of Indigenous Peoples as they relate to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Funds Available

The total amount available for this funding opportunity is \$6,000,000.

The maximum amount for Research Operating Grant is \$250,000 for one year.

The maximum amount per Knowledge Mobilization Grant is \$150,000 for one year.

Application Deadline: Week of December 6, 2021

Notice of Decision: February 28, 2022
