Description

The specific objectives of this funding opportunity are:

- to support planning activities, partnership development and/or increasing understanding of the health research landscape that will contribute to the advancement of research consistent with the mandate of CIHR; and/or;
- to support dissemination events/activities that focus on the communication of health research evidence to the appropriate researcher and/or knowledge user audience(s), tailoring the message and medium as appropriate.

Each of the participating Institutes/Initiatives has tailored this funding opportunity to meet the needs of their respective communities. Please view the Sponsor Description section for specific details.

Eligibility

For an application to be eligible:

1. The Nominated Principal Applicant must be one of the following:
 1. An [independent researcher](#) [1]
 2. A [knowledge user](#) [2]
 3. A [trainee](#) [3]
 4. A [supervisor](#) [4]
 5. An activity/event coordinator affiliated with a Canadian non-governmental not-for-profit organization, and/or a community leader
2. At the time of application, the Nominated Principal Applicant must be affiliated with:
 1. Canadian post-secondary institutions and their affiliated institutions including hospitals and research institutes; or
 2. Canadian non-governmental, not-for-profit organizations (including community or charitable organizations) with an explicit health research or knowledge translation mandate; or

3. Canadian non-federal government departments or agencies, including regional health authorities, when specific programs of those departments or agencies do not fund the activity that forms the subject matter of the grant.
 - If an organization or institution is uncertain about its eligibility for funding through this Funding Opportunity, it is encouraged to seek clarification from the [CIHR Contact Centre](#) [5]
3. Activities/events starting or taking place before the funding start dates are not eligible for funding through this opportunity.
4. Applicants are not eligible to apply for additional funding for an activity or event which has been previously funded by CIHR.
5. Multiple applications for the same activity or event submitted by either the same Nominated Principal Applicant or a different one are not allowable. In such cases, the first application submitted through ResearchNet will be considered and reviewed. Any subsequent applications will automatically be withdrawn.

Maximum Project Value

The maximum amount per grant varies by Institute/Initiative but will not exceed \$50,000. **Please see the [Sponsor Description](#) [6] section of this funding opportunity for details on funding levels specific to each participating Institute/Initiative.**
