Description

The Embassy of France in Canada is launching the 3rd edition of its Mourou/Strickland Mobility Program. This program is intended for French and Canadian researchers (Quebec excluded as there are specific programs between France and the Quebec Government) who wish to spend a short stay (3 to 28 days) with their counterparts, either in France or in Canada, as part of a joint research project.

Research stays may include, but are not limited to: meetings/research on joint project, meetings for a first contact for future collaboration, work on co-publications, participation in French-Canadian (not international) conferences or seminars, etc.

Eligibility

• Researchers who have obtained a tenure-track or permanent position for **less than 10 years**, which corresponds approximately and not exclusively to the 35-45 age group.

French candidates: Be attached to an institute, laboratory, university or research organization

based in France.

<u>Canadian candidates</u>: be attached to a Canadian institution, university or research organization **outside Quebec** (Quebec already has specific programs with France).

- Candidates have never received a grant under the Mourou/Strickland mobility program or the "new collaborations" program of the France Canada Research Fund.
- Candidates should not apply for the "new collaborations" program of the France Canada Research Fund in the same year.

Plan a stay of between **3 and 28 days**. Travel must take place **before December 31st, 2020**.

Maximum Project Value

- 1 round-trip economy-class flight Canada- France or France-Canada
- A contribution towards subsistence costs (maximum 3 daily allowances)
