Eligibility

The KFOC defines a Nominated Principal Applicant as an individual who:

- · will be responsible for the direction of the proposed activities; and
- · will assume the administrative and financial responsibility for the grant or award; and
- will receive all related correspondence from The KFOC.
- Is an independent researcher (Post-doctoral fellows not eligible)
- Canadian citizen or permanent resident (e.g. a person who has been granted admission to Canada as an immigrant)

Eligibility Issues for Biomedical Research Grant

A Nominated Principal Applicant, or Principal Applicant may not apply for or hold more than one (1) Biomedical Research Grant per year from The Kidney Foundation as an award.

A Co-Applicant may apply for or hold one additional Biomedical Research Grant per year.

Eligibility Issues for Special Research Project Grant: Predictive Biomarkers

A Nominated Principal Applicant, Principal Applicant, or Co-Applicant who already holds or is applying for a KFOC Grant is eligible to apply.

Maximum Project Value

Biomedical Research Grant: maximum of \$50,000 per year

Special Research Project Grant: maximum of \$112,500 per year
