Description

The Kidney Foundation of Canada has established a national goal of encouraging and supporting research that may further the current knowledge pertaining to the kidney or improve health in areas relevant to the Vision and Mission of The Kidney Foundation.

The intent of the KFOC is to fund the best kidney research conducted at Canadian universities or other recognized Canadian academic institutions (for more information, please see the CIHR list of eligible institutions: <http://www.cihr-irsc.gc.ca/e/36374.html> [2]). The KFOC will, therefore, allow as many qualified researchers in Canada as possible to compete for its grants and will accept applications from Principal Applicants from various communities and sectors.

The [Kidney Health Research Grant Policies](#) [3] 2020 Competition supersede all previous Kidney Foundation of Canada Biomedical Research Grant Policies. Applicants should always refer to the latest version

Eligibility

The KFOC defines a **Nominated Principal Applicant** as an individual who:

- will be responsible for the direction of the proposed activities; and
- will assume the administrative and financial responsibility for the grant or award; and
- will receive all related correspondence from the KFOC.
- is a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident (e.g. a person who has been granted

admission to Canada as an immigrant) who is an independent researcher.

Note: A Nominated Principal Applicant or Principal Applicant may not apply for or hold more than one (1) Kidney Health Research Grant per year from The Kidney Foundation as an award.

The KFOC defines a *Principal Applicant* as an individual who shares responsibility for the direction of the proposed activities.

Both the Nominated Principal Applicant and Principal Applicant hold a research appointment, usually an employment relationship, with an eligible institution.
