Description

Biomedical Research Grants provide financial support to medical researchers to assist in defraying the operating costs of research, which may include the purchase of materials, supplies and equipment and the payment of laboratory assistants.

Eligibility

The KFOC defines a Nominated Principal Applicant as an individual who:

- will be responsible for the direction of the proposed activities; and
- will assume the administrative and financial responsibility for the grant or award; and
- will receive all related correspondence from The KFOC.
- Is an independent researcher (someone who is autonomous regarding their research activities (e.g. not a trainee, not a post-doctoral fellow, not a research assistant, and not under the supervision of another person, who is directing the research).
- a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident

Note: A Nominated Principal Applicant, Principal Applicant or Co-Applicant may not apply for or hold more than one (1) Biomedical Research Grant per year from The Kidney Foundation as an award.

The KFOC defines a Principal Applicant is an individual who shares responsibility for the direction of the proposed activities.

Funding Availability

Up to \$50,000/year. The maximal budget allowed for two and three year research grants may not exceed \$ 100,000 and \$ 150,000 respectively.

Grants are available for one, two or three years, commencing July 1, 2018
