- 3. Research conducted must have resulted in a significant advancement in scientific knowledge, prevention, treatment or cure of a physically disabling condition
- 4. Research findings must have been published in peer reviewed journals

You must be nominated for this award.

#### **Prize**

The winner will receive a lifetime achievement award of \$10,000.
