The Mitacs Globalink Research Award supports research collaborations between Canada and select partner countries. This award provides \$6,000 for senior undergraduate and graduate students in Canada to conduct 12–24-week research projects at universities overseas.

# **Eligibility**

#### **Students**

- Must be registered as full-time senior undergraduates or graduate students at a Canadian university and remain as such throughout their Globalink Research Award
- Cannot undertake a research project at an institution where they have previously completed a degree and/or been employed
- Cannot undertake a research project in a country where they hold citizenship (unless they are a permanent resident or citizen of Canada).
- Must be the legal age of majority in Canada (18 years of age or older)
- Must meet travel requirements for their intended destination, including visa and/or immigration requirements and associated documentation
- Cannot hold more than one Globalink Research Award per academic lifetime
- · Cannot have previously held a Mitacs-JSPS Summer Program award

### **Undergraduate eligibility**

• Undergraduate applicants must have completed their second year of studies prior to departure and maintain a B average in their two most recent semesters.

### Home supervising professors

- Must hold a faculty position at a Canadian university
- Must be eligible to supervise graduate students and hold Tri-Council funding

### **Host supervising professors**

- Must be recognized faculty members at their institutions
- · Must be eligible to host graduate students
