New Framework for Phasing-In Human Participant Face-to-Face Research now available

The University of Guelph recognizes the vital importance of human participation in its vibrant research enterprise. These activities have been severely impacted by COVID-19. To support and inform the gradual and careful return of these activities, a Face-to-Face Research has been developed.

This new framework is now referenced in an updated version of the <u>University of Guelph Research Phase-In Framework</u> and will assist researchers in returning to human participant research as restrictions ease. It outlines return to research guidelines for decision-making, as well as a checklist to facilitate preparation specific to the phase-in of face-to-face human participant research and adheres to the overarching principle that health and safety are the top priorities. This document emphasizes protocols for on-campus research. A separate document with suggestions and considerations for resuming and implementing projects outside of University grounds will be available soon.

This document does not replace the Research Phase-In Framework, but rather, is meant to function as an addendum to it.
