Natural Sciences and Engineering Research Council of Canada (NSERC)

Description

The **NSERC John C. Polanyi Award** was created to recognize and support a university researcher or team of researchers whose work has led to a recent outstanding Canadian advance in a field of the natural sciences or engineering. The research leading to the advance must have been funded at least partially by an NSERC grant. The award is open to all researchers, regardless of their career stage.

Eligibility

Candidates may be nominated by any individual or group; however, the nominators must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Canada. Self-nominations will not be accepted. Candidates can be at any stage in their career. At least one of the candidates must hold an NSERC research grant. Additionally, the research that led to the advance described in the nomination must have been supported by NSERC.

In the case of a team nomination, members may be from academia, government or industry, and may be research associates, postdoctoral fellows or students. The team can be part of an international effort, but the majority of the nominated team members must be employed at a Canadian university or public or private organization. An individual or team may be nominated for the NSERC John C. Polanyi Award and other major NSERC prizes in the same year, but can receive only one such prize in a given year.

Prize

The winning individual or team will receive a research grant of up to \$250,000. Research grant funds paid to winners of this prize are subject to the <u>Tri-Agency Financial Administration Guide</u> [2].
