NSERC / SSHRC / TIPS Notification for Grant Time Extensions

In the 2024 updates to the <u>Tri-Agency Guide on Financial Administration (TAGFA)</u>, the section on Extension period for the authority to use grant funds (section 3) was updated to clarify that requests for grant extensions, submitted by the administering institution on behalf of grant recipients, will not be considered after the end date of a grant has passed. Therefore, requests for such extensions must be made during the final year of the authority period to use grant funds, and prior to the end of grant date.

Until December 31, 2024, Tri-Agency will accept and consider extension requests for grants ending since April 1, 2024.

The administering institution is responsible for submitting the extension request to the appropriate agency using the Grant Amendment Form. If the extension is not approved, the grant recipient will have three (3) months to pay all expenses incurred before the grant end date.
