How to Apply

There are two applications: one shared application for both undergraduate awards and a separate application for the graduate award.

- Faculty applicants may submit <u>one</u> project for consideration for the undergraduate awards. There is a check box in the application where you can indicate which undergraduate award(s) you would like to be considered for.
- Faculty applicants may submit an application for undergraduate awards and a **separate** application for the graduate award. If you submit the same project for both undergraduate and graduate awards, you **must** clearly explain the roles of students, differentiating between an undergraduate summer research experience and graduate study.
