

Operating Grant: CIHR New Investigator Grants in Maternal, Reproductive, Child & Youth Health

Sponsor

The Institute of Human Development, Child and Youth Health (IHDCYH) in collaboration with the Institute of Aboriginal Peoples' Health (IAPH); Institute of Cancer Research (ICR); Institute of Circulatory and Respiratory Health (ICRH); Institute of Musculoskeletal Health and Arthritis (IMHA); Institute of Neurosciences, Mental Health and Addictions (INMHA); and Institute of Nutrition, Metabolism and Diabetes (INMD)

Description

The program will fund research across the four pillars (biomedical, clinical, health systems services, and population health) that has the potential to have a significant impact on maternal, reproductive, child and youth health outcomes according to the mandates of the participating CIHR institutes. Ultimately, the program aims to strengthen Canada's capacity and knowledge to respond to challenges and needs by providing important early career development support to researchers in these fields.

Eligibility

- The Nominated Principal Applicant (NPA) must be an [independent researcher](#) [1] appointed at an eligible institution (See [Institutional Eligibility Requirements](#) [2] for eligibility process and associated timelines).
- At the time of application, the NPA must also meet both of the following eligibility criteria:
 1. Be within five years (60 months) of their first academic or research appointment (i.e. appointment as an independent researcher providing eligibility to apply for grants and supervise trainees).
 2. Have at least 50% protected time for research.
- If applying to the IAPH funding pool, the NPA must self-identify as Indigenous to Canada (i.e. First Nations, Inuit, or Métis) (see how to apply section).

Funding Availability

\$25,000/ year to a maximum of \$75,000. Enough funding for up to 24 grants
