The objective of CARP is to help canola growers increase yield and profitability, reduce production risk and enhance sustainability with effective technology transfer. In order to achieve these goals, 2021 CARP letters of intent (LOIs) are being solicited on behalf of the three provincial canola grower associations.

Eligibility

CARP will consider research in the disciplines of agronomy, genetics and germplasm development, prioritizing those research areas that have been identified through consultation with expert steering groups, the canola value chain and insights from the annual Canola Discovery Forum.

- 1. Letters of Intent (LOI): Researchers are to submit their LOI directly to the sponsor. Please use this:template [9] for submission of your LOI noting that collaboration with multiple organizations is welcome and encouraged. All submissions should be sent to the attention of Gail Hoskins, CCC Crop Production Administrator and CARP Coordinator at: hoskinsg@canolacouncil.org [10]. Researchers are not required to submit their LOI to the Office of Research for approval before submission to the sponsor, however Researchers are asked to send a copy of their LOI to the Office of Research for information purposes only (no OR-5 required at the LOI stage).
- 2. Full Proposal: Researchers invited to submit a full proposal must submit their full proposal to the Office of Research one weeks in advance of the sponsor's deadline, along with a signed OR-5.
