The <u>Innovation of the Year Award</u> has been developed to recognize and celebrate Guelph innovations that have made, or have the potential to make, significant socioeconomic impacts in Canada and beyond.

How to Apply: Nominations can be made by anyone, including self-nominations. Each nomination can be submitted using the web form at the web link below, which will ask for the following information:

- Name of nominated innovation
- Name of researcher/team
- A brief description of the innovation
- A description of the impact made by the innovation to society, health, the environment or economic development

Award Nomination Process: Nominations should be submitted by Monday, July 31 at noon.
