Food from Thought at the University of Guelph is now accepting applications for a new funding opportunity for graduate students, Leadership Skills for Communicating Change in the Agri-food Sector. Food from Thought is seeking emerging scholars who are passionately committed to fostering sustainable agriculture, promoting nutritious and equitable diets, and developing resilient supply chains for a successful Canadian agri-food system.

These scholarships (up to twelve) are valued at \$10,000 to support University of Guelph graduate students whose research focuses on agriculture and food.

Successful applicants will participate in [UNIV\\*6050](#) [3], a 2-semester graduate course where students collaborate in multi-disciplinary teams with an external partner on a project related to a key agri-food challenge.

### Eligibility

Students entering or registered in any full-time graduate program who will be participating in research focused on agriculture and food and who are (or will be) registered in UNIV\*6050 Innovation and Entrepreneurship in Agri-Food Systems for the first time in the upcoming fall semester are eligible to apply.

UNIV\*6050 is a two-semester course. The next course offering is Fall 2023/Winter 2024. To be eligible to receive scholarship payments, successful applicants must remain registered in UNIV\*6050 in the fall and winter semesters.

Arrell Scholars, Ontario Agri-Food Innovation Alliance–Food from Thought HQP Award Recipients and anyone who has already taken the UNIV\*6050 course are not eligible.

### Maximum Project Value

Scholarships are valued at \$10,000.
