## Program

- The Solutions 2030 Challenge is part of the <u>TargetGHG</u> [1] program, which is supported by funding from the <u>Ontario Green Investment Fund</u> [2]. Ontario's TargetGHG program is designed to catalyze the adoption of innovative low-carbon technologies and foster leading-edge technology development targeting greenhouse gas reductions for industry emitters.
- The Green Investment Fund is a \$325-million down payment on the programming to support the province's new <u>cap and trade program</u> [3] and was announced in the <u>2015</u> <u>Ontario Economic Outlook and Fiscal Review</u> [4].
- Elements of the Ontario Green Investment Fund supports Ontario's <u>Business Growth</u> <u>Initiative</u> [5], helping to accelerate Ontario's innovation economy, while responding to the challenges and opportunities of rapid technological change and global economic forces.
- In May 2015, Ontario became the first province in Canada to set a mid-term greenhouse gas pollution reduction target of 37 per cent below 1990 levels by 2030.
- To Qualify for funding teams must commit to entering into a funding agreement with Ontario Centres of Excellence (OCE)

## Description

Helping businesses innovate while lowering greenhouse gas emissions is part of Ontario's plan to create jobs, grow our economy and help people in their everyday lives. As a result, Ontario is challenging local and international companies to develop the next generation of transformative clean technologies to help fight climate change.

The <u>Solutions 2030 Challenge</u> [6] encourages companies to develop breakthrough technologies that will help Ontario's industrial plants reduce their greenhouse gas emissions, meet the targets set in Ontario's <u>Climate Change Action Plan</u> [7], and increase innovation and entrepreneurship in the province. Ontario has provided support for the Solutions 2030 Challenge with proceeds from the province's carbon market through the <u>Green Investment Fund</u> [2]. The challenge will position Ontario as a global leader in building a low-carbon future while supporting job growth and strengthening the economy.
