SOSCIP (formerly Southern Ontario Smart Computing for Innovation Platform) is a collaborative consortium that connects Ontario's research-intensive post-secondary institutions, IBM Canada Ltd., Ontario Centres of Excellence (OCE) and dozens of small- and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) across the province.

SOSCIP supports researchers from a wide array of disciplines by providing access to advanced computing resources, big data analytics, and expertise not available anywhere else in Canada. (<https://www.soscip.org/who-we-are/> [1]) The organization recently received a \$10-million investment from FedDev Ontario that will support a number of initiatives, all designed to build partnerships to foster industry adoption of transformative technology, commercialize innovative products, continue the development of a highly skilled workforce and foster job creation.
