Submission Information:

Unlike the CPRS National Awards of Excellence, the SSHRC Award of Excellence **does not** require membership with CPRS or an entry fee in order to apply.

Each submission must have been planned, produced and completed within a period of two years prior to the entry deadline. A project may have been started prior to the previous two years, however, the evaluation/completion of the project must have been within the last two years.

Categories

- Small institutions (less than 3,000 full-time students)
- Medium institutions (between 3,000 and 10,000 full-time students)
- Large institutions (more than 10,000 full-time students)

If College-level review is required, your College will communicate its earlier internal deadlines.

Each entry form must include a maximum three (3) page executive summary. Using the R-A-C-E formula as your outline, your summary should include a brief description of the following areas:

- Research
- Analysis, planning and strategy
- Communication, execution and production, including budget and human or other resources
- Evaluation and measurement
