Insight Grants support research proposed by scholars and judged worthy of funding by their peers and/or other experts. Insight Grant research initiatives may be undertaken by an individual researcher or a team of researchers working in collaboration.

Applicants choose from one of two streams, depending on the amount of funding required. Both streams will be adjudicated by the same committees, and will receive the same rigorous level of merit review. The deadlines and application process are identical for both; however, the targeted success rate for Stream A is higher than for Stream B.

SSHRC welcomes applications involving <u>Indigenous research</u> [5], as well as those involving <u>research-creation</u> [6].

Eligibility

Emerging and Established Faculty, Postdoctoral Fellows (<u>read eligibility guidelines</u> [4]). Applicants and co-applicants (except postdoctoral researchers and PhD students) must be affiliated with an eligible Canadian postsecondary institution at the time of application.

Note: Researchers who maintain an affiliation with a Canadian postsecondary institution, but whose primary affiliation is with a non-Canadian postsecondary institution, are not eligible for applicant or Co-applicant status within the Insight Grants funding opportunity.

Co-applicants

An individual is eligible to be a <u>co-applicant</u> [7] if they are formally affiliated with any of the following:

- Canadian: Eligible postsecondary institutions.
- International: Not eligible for co-applicant status.

Please see Subject Matter Eligibility [8] for eligible subject areas.

Maximum Project Value

Insight Grants are valued at \$7,000 to \$100,000 per year, up to a total of \$400,000.

Applicants may choose one of two streams when applying for an Insight Grant, depending on the amount of funding required:

- Stream A for requests between \$7,000 and \$100,000; or
- Stream B for requests between \$100,001 and \$400,000.

Projects whose primary objective is curriculum development, organization of a conference or a workshop, digitization of a collection, or creation of a database are not eligible for Insight Grants funding.

An application will be declared *ineligible* if it is determined that more than 30 per cent of the requested budget has been allocated to ineligible expenses.

Note: that Insight Grant funds may not be used for the remuneration and/or travel and subsistence costs of presenters or guest speakers.
