# **Description**

Open Research Area (ORA) 6 call is an international competition sponsored by SSHRC; Agence nationale de la recherche (ANR), France; Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft (DFG), Germany; and Economic and Social Research Council (ESRC), United Kingdom. In addition, the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS) will collaborate with ORA 6 as an associate partner.

Proposals are required to involve researchers from any combination of three or more participating countries out of Canada, France, Germany and the UK. (Japan is not counted toward the minimum three countries.)

For this sixth ORA call, the ESRC will be the coordinating agency.

This call will follow a **two-stage procedure** consisting of an outline proposal and a full proposal. Applicants who are successful at outline will automatically progress to full stage. Unlike the previous round, **applicants will be invited to submit outline and full proposals at the same time,** rather than waiting for the results of the outline stage.

Funding will be distributed among the national agencies according to the place of work of the researchers, and according to the funding rules of each agency.

There will a webinar for potential applicants to this call on July 3, 2019.

# **Eligibility**

Applications may be submitted by a team of researchers consisting of one <u>applicant</u> [4]and one or more <u>co-applicants</u> [5] and/or <u>collaborators</u> [6].

To apply for the SSHRC funding component of the larger ORA 6 call, the applicant must be affiliated with an <u>eligible Canadian postsecondary institution</u> [7] at the time of application. Applicants are required to ensure that they comply with all SSHRC policies and regulations and complete the necessary SSHRC-specific documents for submission.

Individuals are eligible to be <u>co-applicants</u> [5] if they are formally affiliated with any of the following:

- **Canadian:** Postsecondary institutions; not-for-profit organizations; philanthropic foundations; think tanks; or municipal, territorial or provincial governments.
- International: Postsecondary institutions.

Applicants who have received a SSHRC grant of any type but have failed to submit an end of grant report [8] by the deadline specified in their Notice of Award are not eligible to apply for another SSHRC grant until they have submitted the report.
