Description

Partnership Engage Grants are expected to respond to the objectives of the Insight [2] program and the <u>Connection</u> [3] program. They provide short-term and timely support for partnered research activities that will inform decision-making at a single partner organization from the public, private or not-for-profit sector. The small-scale, stakeholder-driven partnerships supported through the Partnership Engage Grants are meant to respond to immediate needs and time constraints facing organizations in non-academic sectors. In addressing an organization-specific need, challenge and/or opportunity, these partnerships let non-academic organizations and postsecondary researchers access each other's unique knowledge, expertise and capabilities on topics of mutual interest.

SSHRC welcomes applications involving <u>Aboriginal research</u> [4], as well as those involving <u>research-creation</u> [5].

SSHRC invites all applicants to review <u>Imagining Canada's Future</u> [6]'s six <u>future challenge</u> <u>areas and subquestions</u> [7], and to consider addressing one or more of these areas in their research proposal. <u>Summary reports</u> [8] related to the Knowledge Synthesis Grants for each future challenge area have identified possible gaps in current knowledge, which applicants may wish to further explore. While this is not an evaluation criterion for merit review, SSHRC monitors research capacity in these areas, and develops and implements strategies and knowledge mobilization activities to enhance the contribution of the humanities and social sciences across the six challenge areas.

Eligibility

Subject matter

Most SSHRC funding is awarded through open competitions. Proposals may involve any disciplines, thematic areas, approaches or subject areas eligible for SSHRC funding. Please see <u>Subject Matter Eligibility</u> [9] for more information. Projects whose primary objective is curriculum development are not eligible for funding.

Applicants

Applicants must be affiliated with an <u>eligible Canadian postsecondary institution</u> [10] at the time of application. Applicants who have received a SSHRC grant of any type but have failed to submit an <u>end of grant report</u> [11] by the deadline specified in their Notice of Award are not eligible to apply for another SSHRC grant until they have submitted the report. Researchers who maintain an affiliation with a Canadian postsecondary institution, but whose primary affiliation is with a non-Canadian postsecondary institution, are not eligible for <u>applicant</u> [12] status.

Postdoctoral researchers are eligible to be applicants if they have formally established an affiliation with an <u>eligible</u> [10] institution at the time of application, and maintain such an affiliation for the duration of the grant period.

Co-applicants

<u>Co-applicants</u> [13] may be individuals from any of the following:

Canadian: Postsecondary institutions; not-for-profit organizations; philanthropic foundations; think tanks; and municipal, territorial or provincial governments.

International: Postsecondary institutions.

Collaborators

Any individual who may make a significant contribution to the project is eligible to be a <u>collaborator</u> [14]. Collaborators do not need to be affiliated with an eligible Canadian postsecondary institution. Individuals from the private sector or federal government may only participate as collaborators.

Multiple Applications

Individuals may apply for only one Partnership Engage Grant per calendar year. In addition, current Partnership Engage Grant holders may not submit a new Partnership Engage Grant application until their current grant is no longer active. Please refer to SSHRC's <u>regulations</u> regarding multiple applications [15] for more information.

Partner organizations

Only one Canadian or international organization from the public, private and/or non-profit sector may be involved as a partner organization. Partner organizations are expected to support the activities of the partnership through <u>cash and/or in-kind contributions</u> [16]. Researchers involved in <u>formal partnerships</u> [17] that involve more than one partner organization are encouraged to apply for <u>Partnership Development Grants</u> [18] or <u>Partnership Grants</u> [19].

Institutions

Grant funds may only be administered by an eligible Canadian postsecondary institution. Institutions proposing to administer any grant awarded under this funding opportunity must hold or obtain <u>institutional eligibility</u> [10].

Maximum Project Value

\$7,000 to \$25,000

Note: Salary research allowance - Co-applicants from eligible not-for-profit organizations may request a <u>salary research allowance</u> [20] to release them from duties to their organization.

All applicants for SSHRC funding should consult the following guidelines while preparing their applications:

organizations.

- SSHRC, in alignment with its <u>Aboriginal Research Statement of Principles</u> [24], welcomes applications involving <u>Aboriginal research</u> [4]. It also provides <u>Guidelines for</u> <u>the Merit Review of Aboriginal Research</u> [25].
- Applicants may include up to \$7,000 of funding for research and research-related tools in any SSHRC grant application without specifically needing to refer to SSHRC's <u>Guidelines for Support of Tools for Research and Related Activities</u> [26].
 Funding beyond \$7,000 for research or research-related tools is not an eligible expense for the Partnership Engage Grants.

How to Apply

There are four funding cycles per year: September 15, December 15, March 15 and June 15. The results will be announced in November, February, May and August, respectively.

Applicants must complete the application form online in accordance with the accompanying <u>instructions</u> [28]. Applications must be submitted electronically by an authorized

research grants officer, or equivalent, from the applicant's institution.

Note: Once the 8:00pm EST deadline has passed, the application server will be offline for 48 hours and will not be able to accept any additional applications. The application server will come back online after that 48-hour period, ready to accept applications for the next competition deadline.

Information For Co-applicants

If you need to meet a deadline set by the lead institution for this opportunity, please ensure that you provide the Office of Research with at least five days in advance of the lead institution's deadline to review the application, or your proposed component of the project. Please be in touch with the Office of Research at <u>research.services@uoguelph.ca</u> [27] ahead of the deadline if it looks like it will be difficult for you to submit all the required documentation on time (i.e. budget, proposal, OR-5 Form).
