Seeding Food Innovation Grants 2019 Program Guidelines [1]

Description

The Seeding Food Innovation Grants provide seed funding for innovative transdisciplinary research whose goal is to safely increase the production of food and other agricultural products, that will feed and nourish the growing population in ways that are environmentally, economically and culturally sustainable. Research outcomes should impact primarily Canadians, but also deliver key learnings towards issues of global concern.

Key Details

- \$1.5M of seed funding is available for interdisciplinary research or technology development that will help accelerate solutions to today's sustainable food challenges.
- Funding of up to \$250,000 per project for up to two years.
- Projects must be focused on Sustainable Intensification. The program defines this as
 research to increase the production of food and other agriculture products that will feed
 and nourish the growing population in ways that are environmentally, economically and
 culturally sustainable. Examples of focus areas include: Sustainable Agriculture,
 Aquaculture, Soil Microbiome and Food Safety among others.
- Projects must demonstrate meaningful research partnerships and/or collaborations, with a minimum of 1 and a maximum of 10 additional collaborators, beyond the principal applicant. Potential partnerships might include different academic institutions/schools; not-for-profit organizations; public and private organizations or any combination of these.?
- Host organizations must be CRA registered Donees in Canada.
- Principal Applicants must be at the level of a Postdoctoral Fellow or higher or have an Administrative Supervisor that has a permanent post at a recognized Canadian postsecondary institution.
- Principal Applicants should be based at a Canadian institution for at least 30% of their time.

Following evaluation, applications that are deemed to be high potential projects will be invited to submit a Proposal. Only ~15% of LOIs are invited to the Proposal phase so that applicants and reviewers spend their time on Proposals that have an excellent chance of being

funded.
