Description

The funding of these specific grants is made possible thanks to significant collaborations that the Cancer Research Society has developed over the last years with valuable partners. If you apply for a specific grant award, you must check the designated box or boxes on the Letter of Intent and Application forms. You will be required to justify, on the Application form, how your project applies to the specific area(s) of research you selected.

Eligibility

All applicants and co-applicants must hold an academic appointment in a Canadian university or accredited institution. Collaborators may be from outside of Canada however no funds from the Cancer Research Society can be transferred outside of the country. All applicants must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents. Candidates in postdoctoral training are not eligible. Research associates are not eligible.

This competition is a 2-stage submission process: a mandatory Letter of Intent (LOI) and Full Application. Subject to the acceptance of the letter of intent, the Cancer Research Society will invite applicants to submit an official grant application.
