The Industry-Partnered Collaborative Research Operating Grant program provides funding for collaborative research projects involving the academic community and Canadian industry partners sharing an interest in health R&D. The research planned should be beneficial to both parties, while improving the quality of health of Canadians. Projects may be initiated by either party; however, the academic researcher is responsible for applying for the grant.

## **Funding Availability**

Maximum \$250,000/year. The minimum application partner contribution (including eligible inkind contributions) must be at least a 1:1 ratio to the amount requested from CIHR.

### **Project Duration**

up to 5 years

### **Special Notes**

The relationship between the investigators and the application partner must be established and the required level of partner contribution secured from an <u>eligible company</u> [2] at the time the application is submitted.
