Special Notes: For nominations in engineering or the applied sciences, nominators should consult the NSERC <u>Guidelines for the Preparation and Review of Applications in Engineering</u> and the Applied Sciences [2], and prepare the nomination accordingly.

The nominators are responsible for assembling the required documentation, which must follow NSERC's <u>General Presentation</u> [3] format. Only the documents requested by NSERC will be made available to the selection committee.

How to Apply

How to nominate: The nomination process involves three people: (i) the nominator(s); the executive head of the university; and the nominee. The nominator(s) write(s) a letter that explains why the nominee deserves consideration for the Fellowship. The executive head of the university provides a letter endorsing the nomination. The nominee prepares the documentation identified on the <u>nomination page</u> [1].

As was confirmed by NSERC in previous years, nomination letters are to be endorsed by the executive head of the University. Please note, **College Deans** can serve as the executive head for the purposes of these nominations (as well as the AVPR and/or VPR).
