### **Description**

Innovation to Impact Grants (i2I) are intended to support the further development of successful findings based on the goals originally explored through a CCSRI Innovation Grant. Applicants are required to articulate specific achievements from the original Innovation Grant (i.e., significant new knowledge, publications, intellectual property, technology development, or relevant endpoints) and clearly describe and justify the progression to the new research proposed.

### **Eligibility**

Only investigators with a funded Innovation Grant are eligible for this program.

### **Funding Availability**

\$150,000/year – anticipates up to 5 grants awarded.

### **Indirect Costs**

0%

### **Project Duration**

Maximum of 3 years – grants are non-renewable.
