Aboriginal research is a key element identified through SSHRC's Imagining Canada's Future initiative—in particular, "How are the knowledge systems, experiences and aspirations of First Nations, Inuit and Métis peoples essential to building a successful shared future for all Canadians?"

- State of Knowledge and Research Gaps
- Research Data
- Knowledge Mobilization

Faculty and Postdoctoral Fellows (see affiliation requirements).

### **Funding Availability**

Up to \$25,000 – up to 15 grants will be awarded.

### **Project Duration**

One year - however, all synthesis reports must be completed by May 2017.
