

SEEKING PARTICIPANTS GRIEF RESEARCH

We are looking to talk to 18-29 year olds who have experienced the death of someone significant to them in childhood.

The person who died could be a relative, family member, friend, coach, teacher, mentor, leader, or anyone you consider(ed) important to you.

What is the research about?

We want to better understand the changes that happened following bereavement and how young people have made sense of these changes over time.

Why is it important?

We hope the results of this research will help improve community awareness in understanding and supporting the complex experiences of young grievers.

What is involved?

Participants will take part in one 60-90 minute interview and will receive a \$20 gift card. Optionally, participants can also review the research and share their feedback.
